Proposed Introduction of Charges at Tourism and Railway Station Car Parks -Consultations Response

Glen Sanderson, Cabinet Member for Environment and Local Services presented the report to the Committee at its meeting on 6 February 2019. Paul Johnston, Interim Executive Director of Place, together with Paul Jones, Service Director: Local Services were also in attendance to respond to any technical questions.

Councillor Sanderson confirmed that the Administration had no plans to re-open this issue in the future, however he was hopeful that a proposal to provide parking at the former Goosehill School site in Morpeth could be realised by next winter.
