There are currently two applications for developer contributions to SEND in the area. Negotiations are still on going with the developers for two separate applications for 72 and 171 houses respectively. The planning application determinations are likely to be complete in the next three months. The local authority are currently seeking £171 k worth of contributions and would contribute the full amount to this scheme if negotiations and planning applications are successful.

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
