Notification of the Estimated Collection Fund Balances 2018-19 – Council Tax & Business Rates The report will advise Cabinet of the estimated surplus or deficit balances on the Collection Fund in relation to Council Tax and Business Rates as at 31 March 2019. The Local Government Finance Act 1992 (as amended) requires the Council as the Billing Authority to calculate a Council Tax Collection Fund estimate by 15th January each year. The Non-Domestic Rating (Rates Retention) Regulations 2013 require the Council as the Billing Authority to calculate a Business Rates Collection Fund estimate on or before 31st January each year. (N. The report will also recommend that Council approves the submission of the Local Plan to the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government for Independent Examination, following the conclusion of the consultation period on the Publication Draft Local Plan, and delegates authority to the Interim Executive Director of Place, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Planning, Housing and Resilience, to approve any non-material amendments to the Northumberland Local Plan prior to submission of the Northumberland Local Plan to the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government for Independent Examination. Approval of the Council Tax Base 2019/20 The Council is required to set its council tax base annually. The tax base must be set between the 1st of December and 31st January. The tax base is a measure of the Council's taxable capacity which is used for the setting of its council tax. Legislation sets out the formula for calculation.
