Northumberland Waste Strategy - proposed trial of kerbside glass collections The Council's current Municipal Waste Management Strategy (2003 - 2020) requires amendment to reflect the requirements of new legislation within the Environment Bill currently passing through Parliament. This Bill encapsulates the Government's longer term policy direction, as set out in 'Our waste, our resources, a strategy for England', which would require Local Authorities to collect a core set of dry recyclables and provide a weekly collection of segregated food waste.  The report outlines findings of an options appraisal and modelling work recently undertaken to identify the most appropriate way forward to meet the Government's waste policy objectives through improvements to the Council's waste and recycling services to achieve recycling rates in excess of 50%. To achieve this enhanced recycling performance the Council will need to expand the range of dry recyclables collected from households. In particular, the implications of introducing a new four weekly kerbside collection service of glass bottles and jars have been evaluated, to see if this service could be introduced cost effectively, in advance of food waste collections.
