Devolution to North of Tyne

Newcastle, North Tyneside and Northumberland Councils had agreed a "minded to" devolution deal with the Government which would unlock new powers and funding for the region.

To implement the deal the Councils needed to withdraw from the existing North East Combined Authority ("NECA") and establish a new North of Tyne mayoral combined authority. The North of Tyne Councils ("the NT Councils") had consulted on these changes and the Secretary of State had prepared a draft of the statutory order which was required to implement the proposals.

This report requested authority to provide the Council's consent to the making of that statutory order (copy of report attached to the signed minutes). **RESOLVED** unanimously that:-
