<p><b>Report on Outcomes of Statutory Consultation on Proposals for Education in the West of Northumberland</b> This report sets out an analysis of the representations received from interested parties relating to the Council's statutory proposals for some schools in the Haydon Bridge Partnership (Bellingham Middle School and Bellingham, Kielder, Greenhaugh, West Woodburn and Otterburn First Schools and the linked non-statutory proposal for Wark Church of England First School. The Statutory Proposal was published on 10 May 2018 and opened a four week statutory period beginning on that date and closing on 7 June 2018. The Statutory Proposal set out the intention of the Council to close Bellingham Middle School with effect from 31 August 2019 and to extend the age ranges of Bellingham, Kielder, Greenhaugh, West Woodburn and Otterburn First Schools with effect from 1 September 2019. Should these proposals be approved, Cabinet would also be requested to approve the extension of the age range of Wark Church of England First School by two years, for which the statutory process was not required. Cabinet is required in July 2018 to consider the outcomes of the statutory consultation, specifically in the light of the statutory regulations presumption against closure of rural schools, and to make the final decision on whether or not to approve the closure.
