

Table 14: Key Stage 2 SDQ scores and achievement 2018 (8th April 2019)








Average progress 8 score for looked after children, by length of time in care 2018




Post -16 Destinations at 16 – level of study of those in education




Number of phase changes for looked after children 2017-18




Number of looked after children in schools at each Ofsted grade




Overall absence for looked after children 2013-18




Persistent absence of looked after children 2013-18



Attendance of looked after children in Primary and Secondary phases 2016-18




Fixed term exclusions of looked after children 2013-17: proportion of pupils with at least 1 fixed term exclusion


Number of fixed term exclusion by National Curriculum year group 2017-18 (Virtual School data)
