#### **Suggested Conditions:**

The premises personal licence holder/designated premises supervisor shall ensure that no public nuisance is caused by noise emanating from the premises or vibration transmitted through the structure of the premises.

The licence holder shall ensure that all windows remain closed in any room where regulated entertainment is taking place to prevent noise emanating from the premises which is likely to give rise to public nuisance.

The lobby doors at the premises shall be kept closed except for access and egress when regulated entertainment is taking place.

The licence holder shall ensure that all external and lobby doors are fitted with suitable working self-closing devices to prevent noise emanating from the premises which is likely to give rise to a public nuisance.

All refuse emanating from the premises shall be placed in appropriate receptacles with close-fitting lids and appropriate measures shall be taken to ensure that all glass and other sharp or hazardous waste is secured against public access.

The licence holder shall provide clear and legible notices to be displayed at prominent positions adjacent to exits and other circulatory areas requesting patrons to leave the premises having regard to the needs of local residents, in particular emphasising the need to refrain from shouting, slamming car doors and the sounding of car horns.
