My home is adjacent to the above business, and I have concerns about the implications of the above application, if approved. So far there has only been minor inconvenience from the opening of Carnaby's as the business is open daytime hours only. My first concern is the possibility, that this application is an indication that they will be opening all hours.

Through the day, the periods of increased traffic are bearable and there has been no noise issues from the site, but if Carnaby's intend to open at night or even worse for late night events, I have obvious concerns.

Revellers during and exiting from events can be boisterous and loud. Smokers have been known to take the party mood outdoors. The sound level from live music can vary from act to act, but it can be difficult to impose control.

As stated above, there has been no noise issues so far, but if this application is also a precursor to a change to their daytime operation at Carnaby's, my concerns would also extend to their current opening hours.

I know new business opportunities and employment are important for this part of the world, but this is where I live and it is a pleasant place to call home. I hope this application is reviewed carefully and with a clear understanding of Carnaby's owners intentions for the direction of their business, if this application was to be approved.
