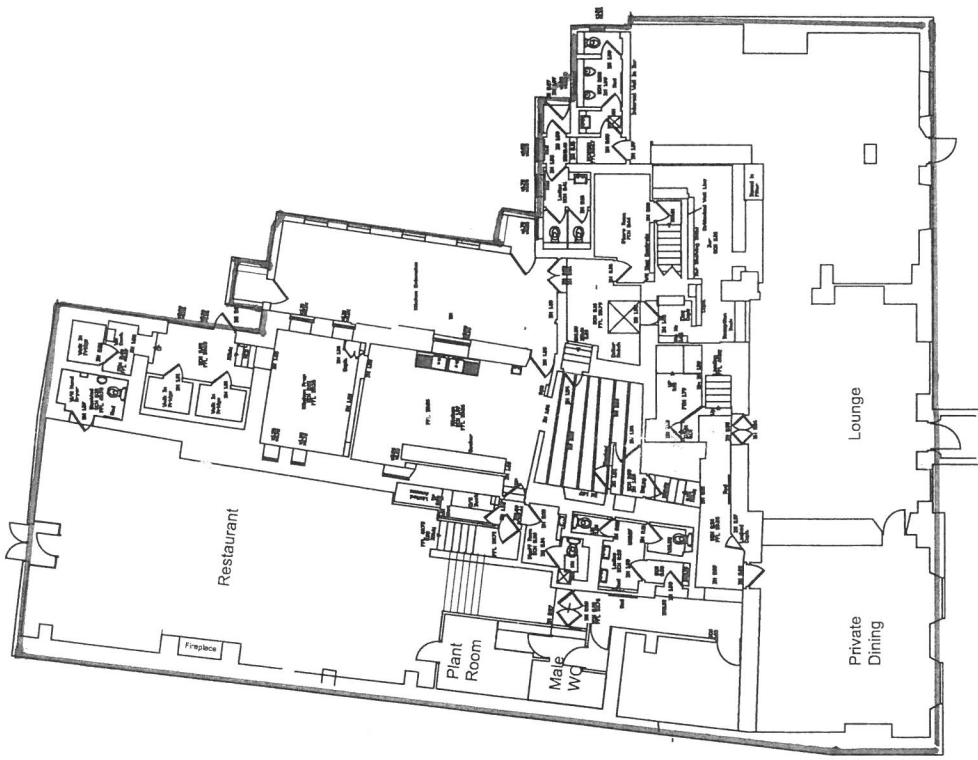

- Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.

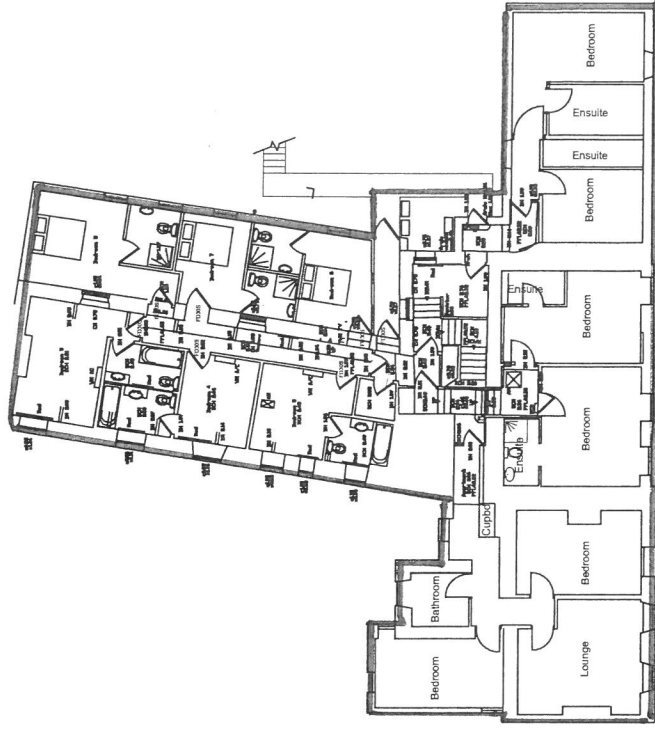

OPERATING SCHEDULE**

1. The operator shall ensure that at all times when the premises are open for any licensable activity there is sufficient, competent staff on duty at the premises for the purpose of fulfilling the terms and conditions of the licence and for preventing crime and disorder.
2. The operator and designated premises supervisor shall conduct a risk assessment for the general operation of the premises and in the case of individual bespoke events.
3. A CCTV system shall be designed, installed and maintained in proper working order, to the satisfaction of the Licensing Authority and in consultation with Northumbria Police. Such a system shall:-
 - i) Be operated by properly trained staff;
 - ii) Be in operation at all times that the premises are being used for a licensable activity;
 - iii) Ensure coverage of all entrances and exits to the licensed premises internally and externally;
 - iv) Ensure coverage of such other areas as may be required by the Licensing Authority and Northumbria Police;
 - v) Provide continuous recording facilities for each camera to a good standard of clarity. Such recordings shall be retained on paper or otherwise may be put on tape or otherwise (for a period of 28 days), and shall be supplied to the Licensing Authority or Police Officer on request.
4. The maximum number of persons permitted on the premises at any one time shall not exceed a figure prescribed by the risk assessment carried out by the Premises Licence Holder in accordance with fire safety legislation.
5. The Designated Premises Supervisor shall ensure that there are effective management arrangements in place to enable him/her to know how many people there are in the premises at times prescribed within the management risk assessment.
6. Licensed activities permitted to take place in the area hatched blue on the approved plans will be limited to sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises only between 1000 hours and 2200 hours daily.
7. Noise from the licensed premises, including noise from patrons or amplified regulated entertainment, shall not be audible beyond the boundary of the premises so as to cause nuisance to nearby residents.
8. No glass material or bottles shall be deposited in any skip, bin or other container of a like nature, located in the open air outside of the premises between the hours of 10.30 p.m and 8.00 a.m and any such skip, bin or container shall not be removed from the premises between those hours.
9. Subject to the exemption within section 150(4) of the Licensing Act 2003, all members of staff at the premises shall seek credible photographic proof of age from any person who appears to be under the age of 21 years and who is seeking to purchase alcohol on the premises. Such credible evidence shall include a

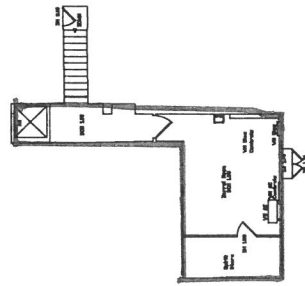
photograph of the customer which will either be a passport, photographic driving licence or proof of age card carrying a PASS logo.

First Floor Plan

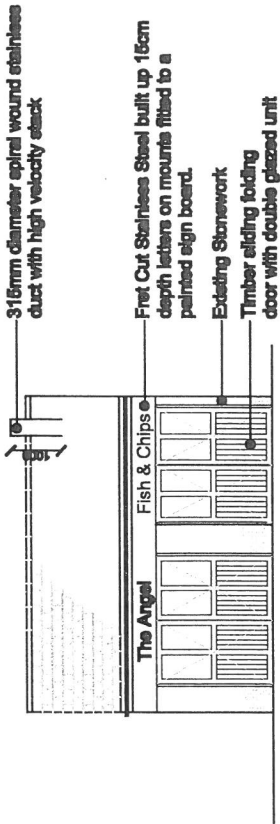


Basement Floor Plan

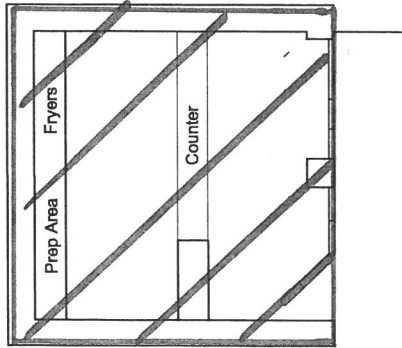

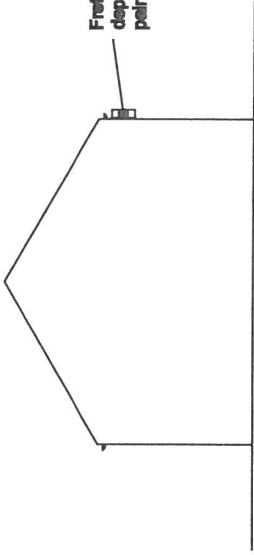

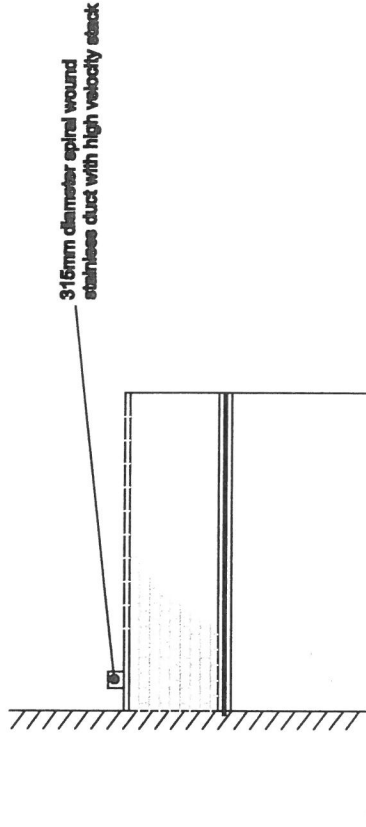
Proposed Front Elevation

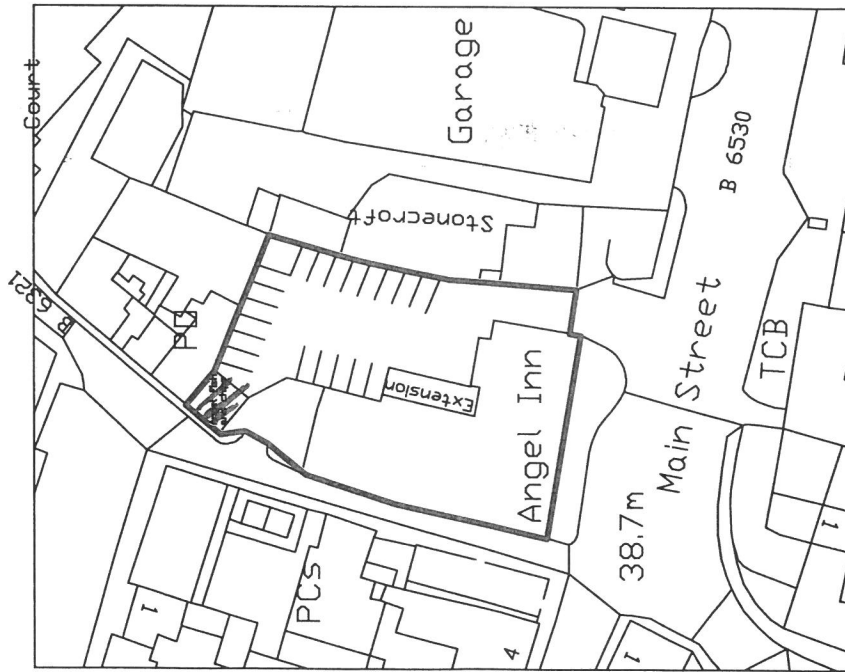
Proposed Side Elevation
