

Agreed conditions with Northumberland County Council Environmental Protection

1. The premises personal licence holder/designated premise supervisor shall ensure that no public nuisance is caused by noise due to amplified music/voices emanating from the premises.
2. The premises personal licence holder/designated premise supervisor shall ensure that amplified music from the premises is inaudible in the nearest noise sensitive residential premises.
3. All doors and windows shall remain closed when regulated entertainment is taking place.
4. Provide clear and legible notices displayed at prominent positions adjacent to exits and other circulatory areas requesting patrons to leave the premises having regard to the needs of local residents, in particular emphasising the need to refrain from shouting, slamming car doors and the sounding of car horns shall also be discouraged. The design and appearance to be approved by the Licensing Authority.
