Good morning,

I am writing to notify you that the solicitor acting on behalf of the applicant has notified me that the marquee will no longer form part of the application. This means it will no longer form part of the licence and as such all references to the marquee will no longer be considered.

There are a number of options available to you:

1. If you believe the withdrawal of the marquee alleviates your fears and you wish to withdraw your representation, could you let me know in writing.
2. Keep your representation as made, but as stated reference to the marquee not considered.
3. Amend your current objection.

I would also like to clarify that a licensed premises is automatically allowed to have regulated entertainment up to 23:00 unconditioned under the Live Music Act. Secondly late night refreshment is the supply of hot food after 23:00

Unfortunately I do not have all the email address of all the objectors, so I have been unable to update some with regards to recent developments.
