Key issues

The Institute of Licensing has published guidance on determining the suitability of applicants and licensees in the hackney and private hire trades.

Background

Under the provisions of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 applicants for hackney carriage and private hire drivers and operators licences must be 'fit and proper' persons to hold licences.



In assessing whether an applicant is a 'fit and proper person' to hold a licence, the Council considers the relevance of convictions and cautions

Northumberland County Council's current policy contains a section on the relevance of convictions. This section of the policy was last reviewed in December 2015.
