






Improving the A1 in Northumberland



- Roads Investment Strategy (2014)
 - £290 million fund to improve the A1 in Northumberland.
 - Delivery by Highways England
- Morpeth to Felton (dualling)
- Alnwick to Ellingham (dualling)
- North of Ellingham





A1 in Northumberland: Scheme objectives



Provide safer, more reliable journeys for local people, visitors, hauliers and agricultural users



Improved journey times and journey time reliability



Provide safe access and egress points for vehicles



Promote economic development within the region



Improve access to and from the wider region for local people and businesses



Latest status...

- Preferred Route Announcement (PRA) Sep 2017:
 - A1 Morpeth to Felton (green route)
 - A1 Alnwick to Ellingham (orange route)
- Work undertaken since PRA:
 - Supplementary survey work acquired
 - Consultation with statutory bodies
 - 3D design model developed
 - Private means of access consulted with stakeholders
 - Public consultation for A1 Morpeth to Felton (Summer 2018)



Alnwick to Ellingham currently



Morpeth Newcastle

- Entirely single carriageway
- Flat junctions
- Used by HGV traffic towards
 Edinburgh and Newcastle
- Long, straight alignment
- Encourages overtaking




Alnwick to Ellingham proposal




- Dual carriageway built online between Denwick and North Charlton
- Split-level junction at Charlton Mires, with bridge over A1 and roundabout with B6347
- Overbridge at Broxfield or Heckley Fence
- New access roads to Eastlink Hall and Westlink Hall (both lose direct A1 access)
- Access road to Rock South Farm
- Environmental mitigation measures











































A2E: What happens next?
