Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan Regulation 19 Decision Statement

Northumberland County Council has resolved to ‘make’ the Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan. The Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan has been brought into legal force. It now forms part of the statutory Development Plan for the Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Area which comprises the whole of the civil parish of Haydon. Decisions on planning applications must now be made in accordance with policies in the Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan unless material considerations indicate otherwise.

The Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan was submitted to Northumberland County Council in November 2021. Publicity was undertaken in accordance with the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. A report following Independent Examination of the Plan was published in March 2022. This report found that, with minor modifications, the Plan passed the necessary legal tests, and it could be put to local referendum. The County Council accepted this recommendation. A local referendum was held in Haydon Parish on 30 June 2022. A majority of those voting were in favour of the Plan being used by the County Council in making decisions on planning applications.

The Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan complies with legal requirements governing the making of neighbourhood development plans set out in the Planning Acts and associated Regulations. Accordingly, I hereby confirm that the Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Plan has been made by resolution of the County Council’s Cabinet on 13 September 2022. Decisions on planning applications in the Haydon Parish Neighbourhood Area must now be made in accordance with policies in the Plan unless material considerations indicate otherwise.
