REVISED JOINT CHARTER WITH TOWN, PARISH AND COMMUNITY COUNCILS

Purpose of report

This report updates Cabinet and seeks approval for the publication of the revised joint Charter between the County Council and the Town, Parish and Community Councils (TPCCs) in Northumberland.

Recommendations

Cabinet is recommended to consider and approve the revised joint Charter attached as Appendix A to this report.

Link to Corporate Plan

This report is relevant to the commitment in the Corporate Plan to strengthen the relationship with TPCCs, working collaboratively to secure the best outcomes for residents, as set out in the 'How – Priorities' in the Corporate Plan. The work with TPCC's underpins the aims and objectives across the Corporate Plan.

Key issues

This revised Charter includes only minor amendments to the 2019 edition and has been prepared following consultation with Northumberland Association of Local Councils (NALC); it defines joint principles to enable NCC and TPCCs to work effectively together to improve the economic, social and environmental well-being of Northumberland.

The key amendments are a) further clarity on Election charges, and b) additional text which commits the Council not to agree to developers and other third parties providing facilities which would normally be the responsibility of the TPCC to provide, maintain and insure, unless the TPCC has given its prior consent to such provision and the conditions associated with this.

BACKGROUND

- 1. In 2009, following Local Government Reorganisation in Northumberland, when the former County Council and the six District Councils were abolished and replaced by one unitary authority, the new unitary Northumberland County Council (NCC) adopted a Local Council Charter. The purpose of the Charter was to define the relationship between NCC and TPCCs. It was designed to enable effective partnership working between the two tiers of local government within Northumberland at a time of significant change. Reviews of the principles within the Charter were undertaken in 2011, 2014 and 2019.
- 2. The implementation of the Charter, and its effectiveness, will continue to be monitored by regular joint meetings of the Town and Parish Liaison Working Group and, as a minimum, the document will be updated after every County Council election.
