The licensing objectives are the prevention of crime and disorder, prevention of public nuisance, public safety and the protection of children from harm.

The activity indicated in this application is for outdoor music - live and recorded in premises serving food and alcohol. Presumably audiences in excess of 500 are anticipated, since no licence is required for less. The vast majority of these audiences is likely to come from outside Pontland and, since public transport, other than taxis is virtually non-existent, there is bound to be major traffic congestion and noise, leading to disorder and public nuisance. The increased volume of traffic late at night is also detrimental to public safety. All those people coming out into the centre of Pontland late at night could result in scenes of disorder such as those seen regularly in the centre of Newcastle, but without the policing required to maintain order. It is stated in the 'Agreed Conditions' that music from the outside entertainment will be inaudible at the nearest domestic residences. This is patently impossible as the nearest house is only about 50 metres away from Rianto. Such music will definitely be a public nuisance.
