I object to this premises application on the understanding that it is to be used as the provision of live music both indoors and outdoors along with the sale of alcohol for consumption both on and away from the premises until late evening.

I believe the above to have a major impact on all 4 licensing objectives and the size of the village would have difficulty handling a further 500 revellers. This has been demonstrated in regular evening events such as the annual Free New Years Eve Firework display which attracts vast numbers of young people to the pubs and village and we have witnessed many incidences of bottles & glasses being hurled by youngsters under the influence of alcohol. We now no longer attend this event as a family because of the clear danger to our safety.

We certainly have objection to this becoming a regular occurrence in a village known for looking out for each other. I worry for the already fragile state, through covid, of our significant elderly feeling vulnerable to such displays.

Parking is already a huge problem here and further

vehicles trying to find places to park would threaten public safety and cause major disorder and nuisance to the public.

I strongly object to this application and hope you will consider the well being of our village & community as a priority
