I would like to lodge my objection to the planned outdoor entertainment/ drinking area. I am aware that the applicants, an ex ponteland publican landlord and current restaurateur intend to create a city centre type (The stack style) drinking and entertainment out-door area which i believe will create noise pollution, anti social behaviour and general neighbourhood disturbance. Ponteland village has enough pubs and restaurants to meet the demand from locals and nearby villages. This arrangement would probably temporarily draw in more customers adding to the all of the obvious problems associated with late night drinking. We know from the experience of festivals which although enjoyable and only once a year create a air of drunken behaviour linked to petty crime and damage. A weekend routine of festival time entertainment would result in more glasses being left smashed around the village and drunken anti social behaviour together with the sound of music and public noise travelling to nearby village residents on Main Street, Darras Road, Belle Villas, North Road, west road callerton land, Dunsgreen and Eland Haugh estate.
