While I appreciate the intention of Conditions 18 and 19 they would appear to be unworkable both from an enforcement point of view as no sound level figures are stated and the fact that the requirement for music to be inaudible at the residential boundaries would effectively prevent the apparent purpose of the venue which is to play live and recorded music for public entertainment

I assume a planning permission is also required and indeed Rob Murfin your Director of Planning has indicated that it is. This is a particularly tranquil part of the conservation area and, if permitted, this is likely to lead to a raft of complaints to the Council
