We wish to object to the application from Suna Miah for license RXA.HOL356.1 for 1a Main Street, Ponteland .In accordance with your licensing objectives the objections are as follows:

1. Prevention of crime and disorder – disorder often goes hand in hand with the consumption of excess alcohol and as the premises are open until after 23.00 hours we feel this will occur.
2. Public safety – excessive drinking the River Pont and a busy road (which will see an increase in traffic) adjacent to the proposed site. Alcohol can impair peoples' judgements.
3. Noise must be inaudible from the boundary of the nearest residential property. Noise is already audible from other sources near our property but not every night. The application is for music every night. Does this also mean recorded music will be allowed after 20.30 hours?
