Dear Sirs

We would like to raise a couple of points in relation to Rialto's plans for the Licence Application.

1. General Disorder.

The likelihood of disorder with the proposed amount of people is probably going to occur on certain occasions. A mixture of young people combined with alcohol and possible drug use could lead to disorder.

2. Music.

Music levels that can't be heard at the nearest residential house seems an impossibility.

Although Ponteland is a pretty big village, I think the proposed plans showing a maximum capacity of 800 people is far too ambitious and I don't feel it's in keeping with the general nature of the area. It's likely the potential customers would come from outside the area which could bring some unwelcome problems.
