Dear Sir/Madam

I would like to strongly object to the proposed new premises license application for outdoor live music and late-night refreshments behind Rialto, 1 Main Street, Ponteland.

I have several concerns about the proposal, which are succinctly summarised as follows.

- Antisocial behaviour - late night drinking and the increased risk of antisocial behaviour, particularly from people visiting from outside the area 'clashing' with locals.
- Noise - this new premise license will result in significant noise levels, particularly with the outside music, in very close proximity to residential areas. Noise pollution from the Severn Stars can already be heard in residential areas and this would significantly add to this.
- Ambience - the proposal is in no way keeping with the existing ambience and character of Ponteland village. The village does not need the new premises - there are plenty of existing facilities with sufficient capacity.
- Encouraging all day drinking - bad for everything.
