We would like to lodge our objections to the proposed development at Rialto restaurant Ponteland.

The CCTV security will only cover the area within the proposed venue leaving the area outside to be covered by the Police. At present there does not appear to be the police presence located locally to deal with the present antisocial behaviour and so we are concerned any additional requirement of their services due to the large capacity of the proposed venue could not be met.

Another concern we have is the proposal of live and recorded music from 11 am till late seven days a week as at the odd time when live music is played at other venues in Ponteland we can hear this quite plainly at our residence. This music is usually for 2 or 3 hours on a Sunday afternoon not every day of the week till late at night.

We are also concerned that the proposed venue is not in a suitable location to cope with the comings and goings of large groups of people especially at closing time.

The original Rialto restaurant has over the years attracted many people including families with young and elderly members who have had safe and close access from the current car park. If this proposal goes ahead this car park will be lost with no alternative safe parking shown on the plans and no other parking available in close proximity to the venue. The one-way road system shown on the plan will also take away some parking spaces.
