I would like to strongly object to the proposed plans to increase capacity at Rialtos Ponteland through the addition of an outdoor seating and eating area. The grounds of my objection are outlined below:

Nuisance

The application allows for live music to be played between the hours of 11am and midnight, this would cause significant public nuisance especially when coupled with the noise generated by the crowds in the proposed outside area. My property already suffers from considerable noise pollution caused by live music from the Seven Stars and often prevents my getting to sleep at night even with all the doors and triple glazed windows shut! Granting another license would only exacerbate this existing issue.

Given the capacity of the proposed development and the limited availability of parking within Ponteland Rialto patrons may end up parking at the new School / Leisure complex or in the residential streets close to the village centre causing a nuisance local residents and their visitors.

Public Safety

The capacity of the proposed development will cause additional traffic and potential tail-backs from the roundabout between Lloyds bank/Rialtos back to the traffic lights opposite the Diamond Inn. Pedestrians may be forced to cross the roads between cars should the traffic not be able to clear the crossings freely.

Crime & Disorder

Due to Pontelands limited public transport links late at night and the level of drunken patrons, increased Crime and Disorder is of great concern at closing time, not only in the main street area but also within Ponteland Park which my house directly backs on to.
