The conditions detail only that records of ejections of patrons and incidents of disorder shall be kept. Not that any steps will be used to manage the behaviour of patrons either on or outside of the premises.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The conditions detail only that steps shall be taken to reduce the level of noise where it is likely to cause a disturbance to local residents. It does not describe whether the steps will be checked for effectiveness or whether the local residents will be consulted on the efficacy of the measures taken.

The mitigation of noise disturbance is limited to that from regulated entertainment and omits to mention the noise from people at the premises, crowds arriving or leaving, cars, etc

e) The protection of children from harm

Given that the application is for entertainment from 11am to midnight and 7 days per week then the increased activity in the area will inevitably impact on people that retire to bed early. This will include children.

The lack of parking at the premises will increase the risk to children as customers will be inclined to park on residential streets.
