I wish to object to the licencing of the proposed development at the rear of Rialto's Ponteland.

1. Prevention of Public Nuisance

This will create a noise nuisance to the surrounding areas. There are residential houses and flats nearby on Callerton Lane and a house directly behind.

This would encourage an additional influx of people from outside the area for the purpose of drinking and partying, giving rise to an increase of rowdy behaviour in the area and parking problems. Providing a taxi rank, which we understand excludes local taxis is discriminating against local businesses.

The existing car park behind Lloyds Bank is for their customers and is needed for people using the cashpoint pr the bank in office hours. This new proposal would mean that those spaces would be taken up by people visiting the 'Stack' rather than the bank.

2. Public safety

The access to the site is very narrow and people need to be able to walk on that stretch of road from the Lloyds car park to get to the cash point as there is no pavement.

At capacity this would lead to approximately 200 additional cars into Ponteland which will give rise to traffic problems and safety. It will generate more traffic onto the A696 which is already a very busy road. Where will these additional cars park? Although car parks already exist in the area they are well used. This potentially gives rise to cars parking on roadsides which could generate safety problems for pedestrians and other motorists.
