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## APPOINTMENT OF PARISH COUNCIL REPRESENTATIVES TO STANDARDS COMMITTEE

#### REPORT OF THE MONITORING OFFICER

#### **Brpose of report**

To appraise members of the progress made with regard to the appointment of the three Parish Council representatives to the Standards Committee

#### **R**commendations:

It is recommended that Members;

- (1) note the position thus far with regard to the appointment process relating to the vacancies for the three Parish Council representatives to the Standards Committee and
- (2) accept the application from the third applicant even though it was submitted out of time
- (3) either;
- (a) proceed to interview three applicants who applied for the role of Parish Councillor Representatives on the Standards Committee or
- (b) If members do not accept the out of time application, resolve that the Monitoring Officer contacts Northumberland Association of Local Councils and requests that the positions be advertised for one final time after which interviews would take place.

#### Ink to Corporate Plan

This report is relevant to the 'How' Priority – namely 'We want to be efficient, open and work for everyone'

#### Ky issues

- 1. There is a need to appoint Parish Council representatives to the Standards Committee following vacancies arising after the last election
- Members resolved on the last occasion that an interview panel comprising the following be set up with delegated authority to make recommendation to Council regarding the appointment of such representatives, Mr. J. Jackson, Councillors B. Flux and A. Wallace.
- 3. There are currently three Parish Council vacancies but only two applications were received within the timescale with a third application being submitted late.

#### **B**ckground

- 1. The current composition of this Committee provides for three Parish Council representatives to be appointed. Following the resignation of the previous Parish Council representatives towards the end of the term of the last Council, expressions of interest have been invited from serving Parish and Town Councillors to join the Committee through the offices of Northumberland Association of Local Councils and interested parties have been invited to contact the Council's Deputy Monitoring Officers.
- 2. The closing date for applications expired 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021 and only two applications were received within that timeframe. This was the second occasion that the positions had been advertised, insufficient expressions of interest having been received on the first occasion.
- Members recommended that an interview panel be set up in anticipation of a number of applications having been received. However, only two applications were received within the timeframe. One late application was received outside of the timeframe in the New Year.
- 4. With regard to the interview process officers are in the process of contacting Monitoring Officers within the LA7 group of authorities with a view to how the appointment of Parish Council representatives was approached within those authorities and can provide an update at the Committee in this regard.
